Poster Presentation Guidelines

- Format: A0 portrait (84.1 cm x 118.9 cm)
- Font sizes:
 - Title 70 – 100 pt
 - Body Text 24 – 36 pt
- Image Resolution: 150 – 300 dpi
- A General Rule of Thumb:
 - 20-30 % text
 - 40 % graphics
 - 30-40 % empty space
- Allow enough time for printing (minimum 4 days), QUT printing services will be busy at this time.

Poster Judging Criteria

- Appearance:
 - Visual appeal
 - The ability of poster to draw reader to the main point without input from student
- Content:
 - Title conveys content and importance
 - Introduction suits a “lay” reader
 - Study design/methods are sufficient in detail but not overwhelming
 - Results are clear and presented in one form, not repeated in text
 - Discussion/conclusion summarises results and delivers final message
- Presentation:
 - Clear presentation of the topic
 - Presenter engages the reader enthusiastically
 - Presenter demonstrates extensive knowledge in field
 - Questions are answered insightfully and thoughtfully
- Real World Implication:
 - Posters will be judged for strength of real world implications
